Academic Performance

Strong academic performance is expected from each applicant, and all who apply must have at least a 3.0 grade point average. Please enclose an "unofficial" transcript from high school and college, if appropriate; an official transcript will be requested from the scholarship recipient only.

Community Service

Service to the community is how we keep our communities strong. All applicants should explain the role that service to their community plays in their life. Please include in a separate envelope or by email (sent directly to SMRFA) at least one letter of recommendation from someone who can describe the service work the applicant does in the community.
